In Vedanthangal, schools have reopened after the summer holidays.

The children are gradually returning to the after-school centres, nursery, and IT centres, settling back into their daily activities. Meanwhile, our university students are still enjoying their well-deserved summer break.

Kavitha, from Puthupattu village in Tamil Nadu, lost her mother and grew up with her father and two sisters, facing financial hardship. Kavitha always wanted to be a secondary school teacher but did not have the funds to be able to pursue her dream. She joined the Indian Futures Student Sponsorship Programme in 2019, which helped her be able to study and complete her Bachelor of Arts degree. With the help of her Sponsors, she was able to get into a teaching job and start a career she always hoped to.

Our Students Sponsorship Programme subsidises the university fees, transport and the educational material of 14 female students a year. They also have access to mentoring throughout their studies and support with skills to get into employment after graduating. Supporting girls' education enables them to break through the cycle of poverty, equipping them with essential skills to transform their lives.
