Our Impact

Since our IT centres opened...

- 122 students between the ages of 5 and 12 attended our 3 IT Community Centres in their first year (2019/20).
- 90% of our IT students achieved the desired level of understanding and handling of IT software.
- All our IT students showed a higher level of understanding and handling of IT software than those not attending the centres.







Our Goals

- Open our IT centres to the entire community.
- Improve our centres, with better facilities and more specialised IT teachers' training.



What we need

In order to achieve our goals, in the school year 2023/24 we need a total of £23,573. This covers the costs of:

- 30 laptops,
- 2 FT IT teachers, 1 PT IT supervisor and the project coordinator's salaries (one year),
- 4 teachers and the supervisor's training (one year).



We also need advice on IT educational programmes, software and teachers' training.
