Digitalisation of education is one of the keys to this challenge, as it solves problems in rural schools such as inadequate student-teacher ratios and insufficient teaching resources.

In order to meet this challenge, Indian Futures has created 3 IT Community Centres.



Our Impact

Since our IT centres opened...

- 122 students between the ages of 5
 and 14 attended our 3 IT Community
 Centres in their first year (2019/20). By
 March 2025, a total of 573 have
 benefited from learning new IT skills.
- 90% of our IT students achieved the desired level of understanding and handling of IT software.
- All our IT students showed a higher level of understanding and handling of IT software than those not attending the centres.







Our Goals

- Open our IT centres to the entire community.
- Improve our centres, with better facilities and more specialised IT teachers' training.



What we need

In order to achieve our goals, in the school year 2025/26 we need a total of £5,500.

This covers the costs of:

- 2 new laptops,
- 50% of refurbishment works in two of the centres, including a new roof, floor tiling and new windows.



We also need advice on IT educational programmes, software and teachers' training, and locally sourced IT equipment (Tamil Nadu).
